**Live-out Part-time Nanny Position in East Boise:** A family expecting twins (possibly preemies) are seeking a nanny to assist with their two-year-old daughter and newborn twins on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8 AM to 4 or 5 PM. They are seeking a nanny that can be flexible with family needs as they are adjusting to the arrival of their infants. A nanny that is patient, calm, and can interact well with babies, toddlers, and parents is preferred. Preschool-age, infant and preemie experience is desired. Pay range: \$15-18 per hour. Start date: February or sooner.

**Live-out Nanny Position in Eagle:** Thirty to thirty-five hours per week, Monday through Friday with a preschooler and a school-aged child. Other duties: Light housekeeping, light cooking, errands and transportation for children to activities and from school.

Pay range: \$13-15 per hour. Start date: January/February.

**Filled: Live-out Full-time Nanny Position in East Boise:** This family is seeking a consistent and enthusiastic nanny that will give genuine care and guidance to their two preschool-aged girls. Their ideal nanny will help their children learn self-confidence and problem solving through their daily activities together. The schedule will generally be day hours Monday through Friday. Thirty-four hours per week can be guaranteed with some weeks up to 40 or more hours, so a nanny with a flexible attitude is needed for this position. Other skills needed for this position are healthy cooking, a sense of tidiness and organization, and the ability to plan creative activities –indoor and outdoor – for their girls. Pay range: \$14-16 per hour plus paid vacation.

**Filled: Live-out Part-time Nanny Position in North End Boise:** A six-month-old baby boy awaits his new nanny with a Tuesday and Thursday schedule, 7:00/7:15 AM to 5:00 PM. His parents would like an interactive nanny that will play with him, read stories and take him on lots of walks in the North End. An experienced nanny with educational background is preferred. Bi-lingual is desirable, but not required. This household has two indoor cats. Pay range: \$14-17 per hour.

**Filled: Live-out Part-time Elder Caregiver Position in Boise:** Four days per week, four hours per day providing light assistance and companionship to a Boise woman in the Collister neighborhood. She and her family are seeking a friendly and outgoing companion for her that can assist with cooking, encourage good nutrition, drive to outings, and plan activities and light exercise including assisting her to walk her friendly

dog. Other duties include shopping and errand assistance, med reminders, and assistance with light housekeeping tasks. Caregiver experience required, and maturity is a plus. Pay range: \$12-16 per hour. Start date: ASAP.

**Filled: Live-out Part-time Nanny-Family Assistant Position in Eagle:** Mornings, 7:30 to Noon, Monday through Friday. Assist two children in their morning routine and getting ready for school on a daily basis, and assist with the care of an infant girl. Other duties include basic meal preparation and household tasks such as cleaning the kitchen, children's rooms, and other areas as time allows. An ideal candidate would enjoy both caring for children and caring for a beautiful home. Pay: \$15 per hour. Start date: ASAP.

**Filled: Live-out Nanny Position in Eagle:** Thirty hours per week, Monday through Thursday caring for a four-month-old infant boy. Walks and outdoor time, reading, interaction and learning activities are important events in his daily routine. Other duties include helping with light household tasks and assisting with meal preparation. Infant experience required. Pay range: \$13-16 per hour plus PTO.

**Filled: Live-out or Live-in Full-time Nanny Position in SE Boise:** 7/8:00 AM to 5/6:00 PM Monday through Friday schedule for an infant due in November. Occasional extra or late hours may occur. This position is to start the first of December, but the parents are interviewing currently. They are seeking a mature, trustworthy, and punctual individual who will provide loving and attentive care for their infant and support their routine and parenting style. Other duties include baby laundry, organizing the baby's clothes and toys, cleaning bottles and tidying the kitchen as needed. An ideal nanny candidate would enjoy taking the baby out walking daily and be comfortable including their large friendly dog in the daily walk. Minimum commitment needed: Eighteen months. Pay range: \$13-18 per hour plus paid vacation.

**Filled: Live-out or Live-in Full-time Nanny – Family Assistant in Boise:** Full days Monday through Friday plus overnights one week per month when parents are "on call". Private room and bath provided for overnights. This position requires a flexible nanny who is comfortable with relatively long workdays and occasional evening and weekend hours when the on-call schedule requires it. Providing childcare for their two-year-old son and twin infants due in the spring would be the focus of this position. This family is seeking a nanny who can be physically active with the children, and take their two-year old outdoors daily, and on outings to park, zoo, museums, etc. and read to him daily. (No TV). Other duties: Light housekeeping /meal preparation. Also important is the ability to reinforce the parents' values/style and work amiably with parents. Pay range: \$13-15 per hour to start, and after babies' arrival \$15-17 per hour.

**Filled: Live-out Part-time Nanny Position in Boise:** This position is a Tuesday-Wednesday schedule approximately 7 AM to 5 PM (20 hours per week) providing attentive care for an infant girl. This family's ideal nanny would be responsive and flexible to their baby's needs and have an outgoing and interactive personality and be willing to assist with light household tasks. Preferred but not required would be a

**bilingual – English and Spanish** – speaking nanny. Also preferred is a nanny that has some background in early childhood education. The duration of this position is six months with the option of extending to one year or longer. Pay range: \$12-16 per hour.

**Filled: Live-out Part-time Nanny Position in North End Boise:** Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM caring for a ten month old boy. His routine includes lots of outdoor play time and outings to park and library. This family has a pool, so their nanny must be able to swim. During school vacations, some supervision / transportation to activities of school age siblings may also be needed. This family's ideal nanny would reinforce their family's values of courtesy, honesty, kindness, respect, and a healthy lifestyle. Duties include light housekeeping, preparing lunch, tidying up the kitchen and light laundry when needed. Excellent communications skills and the willingness to keep a nanny journal are required. Pay range: \$13-15 per hour plus paid vacation.

**Filled: Live-out Family Assistant / Nanny Position in North End Boise:** Three days per week generally (days may vary each week but will be weekdays) 6:30 AM to 7:30 PM, approximately 39 hours per week. Also, this position requires the ability to be "on call" seven days per month when the parent is "on call", with possible overnights during this time. This family has two young school-aged boys who will benefit from the care of an energetic, outdoorsy nanny who will enjoy being active with them, yet provide safe consistent boundaries. Other duties in this position are light household tasks, laundry, shopping, errands, meal preparation including dinner preparation, and transporting the boys to school and activities. Most of the household tasks can be completed while the boys are at school. Pay range: \$12-17 per hour based on experience plus paid vacation and holidays.

**Filled: Live-out Part-Time Nanny Position in Hidden Springs (Boise):** Approximately twenty hours per week, weekday mornings caring for a toddler and his infant sister (due in the fall). "Firm, but fun" is how the parents describe their parenting style and they hope to hire a nanny with a similar positive outlook and good communication skills. In addition to the twenty hours per week, they may need some extra help from their nanny for a few weeks after their new baby arrives. Pay range: \$14-16 per hour.

**Filled: Live-out Nanny Position in East Boise:** This family is expecting twins and has a three-year-old son. They are seeking just the right nanny ASAP to interact with their son and provide light assistance to mom who is currently on bed rest. Once the twins are born – sometime this summer – help with infant care will be appreciated as well as engaging their older son in activities he enjoys such as swimming, biking, basketball, and outside play. From time to time, assistance with errands or light household tasks may be requested. This family is seeking an active nanny who can flow between infant care, interaction with a three-year-old, and coordinate well with parents. The schedule is to be approximately 35 hours per week, Monday through Friday. This position is expected to be seven to twelve months in duration. Pay range: \$13-16 per hour.
