Live-out Nanny Position in East Boise: A family with infant twins is seeking a great nanny that will give their babies lots of loving attention and interaction. This is a short-term position starting March 30 and ending June 4, 2010. The schedule: Tuesdays and Thursdays Noon to 7:00 PM and Monday, Wednesday, Friday 9:00 to 4:00 PM. Important qualities are punctuality, reliability, good communication skills and a natural ability to support the babies' routine and the parents' style. Nanny candidates must have verifiable infant experience to be considered. Experience with multiples would be a plus. Pay range: \$15-17 per hour based on experience.

Live-out Nanny / Family Assistant Position in Eagle: Assisting a stay-at-home Mom with the daily routine of caring for toddler twins and their five-year old sibling. Other important duties are assisting with household needs, laundry, cooking, errands, and shopping. Generally, the schedule will be Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday afternoons/ evenings. This position includes a minimum of 15 hours per week but may be up to 25 hours or more per week with the weekly schedule being determined in advance. This family is seeking a calm, encouraging family assistant that can integrate well with their family style. Pay range: \$15-17 per hour based on experience plus paid time off.

Filled: Live-out Part-time Nanny/Family Assistant Position in Boise: Monday through Friday mornings 6:30-10:30 and Mon/Wed/Fri afternoons 2:30-5:30 caring for a four-year-old boy, transporting him to/from his private school daily and assisting with household management tasks after school drop-off time. These tasks will include errands, light cooking, cleaning (reasonable expectations), laundry, and organization. This family is seeking an active, dependable, and attentive nanny that loves interacting with children and enjoys helping the household run smoothly. Their nanny would encourage the child's varied interests in sports, active play, reading, games, and artwork. An ideal candidate would have the above schedule availability for the next two years. (College students may be considered, but **must** be able to schedule classes around this set work schedule for the next **two years**). This family is looking for an assistant with a high level of commitment to her work.
Pay: \$15 per hour plus three weeks of paid vacation per year. Additional pay for a Spanish-speaking bilingual nanny. Yearly, the month of July will be "Off". Start date: As soon as possible.

Filled: Live-out Nanny / Family Assistant Position In Boise's North End: Providing nurturing care for an infant boy and assisting with household tasks, errands, and light

cooking. The schedule generally includes three weekdays (Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday) plus two evenings per week to make a thirty-six hour week. This family would like a long-term nanny that will model an active healthy life / eating habits and reinforce learning concepts and their baby's daily routine. This family has a large friendly indoor dog that is "part of the family". Pay range: \$14-17 per hour plus paid time off.

Filled: Live-in Nanny Position in Sacramento, CA: Assisting a family with three children, ages four to thirteen years old. The work schedule is generally four days per week and typically 45 hours per week including one to two weekend days per month. There may occasionally be other variations in schedule, but a one-month work schedule is provided in advance. Their new nanny will be provided with a private bedroom and have free access to a car for her personal and work use. Starting pay is \$400 per week plus room and board, vehicle use and a \$50 per week fuel stipend. Two weeks of paid vacation per year. A one-year commitment is requested.

Filled: Live-out Nanny in Boise: This family is seeking a full-time / long-term nanny to provide childcare for their daughter, now ten months old. The work hours are 8 AM to 6 PM Monday through Friday. They are seeking an individual that has an understanding of child development and can reinforce educational concepts. It will be important to help maintain their baby's daily routine and take her on regular walks and outings. The family has a pool, so their nanny needs to be able to swim with their child. Additional duties will be to assist with baby laundry and household shopping and errands. Starting salary is in the range of \$600 per week with paid holidays and vacation.

Filled: Live-out Nanny / Family Assistant in Palm Desert, CA: This family is seeking a nanny that can assist them with three young children and light household duties (cooking, tidying, kitchen clean-up, whatever is needed day-to-day) including some daytime hours, one to three evenings per week (latest would be 10:30 PM) and two weekends per month, totaling 25-40 hours per week. They are seeking a candidate with a sunny and encouraging demeanor that can be somewhat flexible with their schedule and household needs from day to day. They will consider a mom that has raised children or a young nanny with verifiable childcare experience with toddlers and preschoolers. Either way, excellent references are required. Pay range: \$14-15 per hour for weekday/evening hours and \$16-17 per hour for weekend hours for the right candidate. To be considered for this position, you must have your own housing in the Palm Desert area.

On Hold: Live-out / Live-in Family Assistant / Personal Assistant Position in Meridian and Florida. In this position, the FA would assist the "at home" mother of a five-month-old infant in her daily activities of running the household and caring for her child. She would be acting as a personal assistant to this mom and help with tasks such as cooking, laundry, tidying, shopping, and errands. Half the year would be working as a live-out FA in Idaho, and half the year with the family at their second home in the Tampa, Florida area. A private bedroom and bathroom (with use of guesthouse living

room and kitchen) will be provided in the family's guest house near the family's home in Florida. The weekly work schedule would generally be 40 hours per week and, in addition, may sometimes include some evening hours and up to four overnights per month when the father travels for business. Essential qualifications are: Flexibility, maturity, ability to work closely with parents in their home, willingness to travel/ live in Florida, proven experience with infants, stellar references, comfortable around a large friendly dog and several cats.

Filled: Live-out Nanny / Family Assistant in Boise Foothills: This busy household with infant twins and a three-year-old is seeking a flexible and friendly nanny / FA to assist parents and their "primary" nanny with child and infant care, cooking (recipes are provided) and light household tasks and occasional errands. These duties would be shared with the primary nanny. The position involves thirty to forty hours per week generally (Twenty-five can be guaranteed). The hours would be Noon to 6:00 or 7:00 PM Monday through Friday and a few regular evening and weekend hours that would be predictable on a monthly basis.

Filled: Live-out Family Assistant-Nanny Position in Boise: Twenty-five to thirty hours per week, three to four days per week, late morning to early evening. More hours may be needed during children's school vacations. This position is a combination of childcare for two young school-age children and caring for the household needs when the children are in school. Typical duties would be transporting children home from school and to activities, being active with the children in the outdoors, preparing healthy meals and snacks, assisting with dinner prep, and other household duties/organization, errands/shopping for the family, and assisting with three dogs that are "part of the family." When the family travels, their nanny may be asked to housesit or travel with them. Pay range: \$14-15 per hour plus paid time off.

Filled: Live-out Nanny Position in Boise: Monday-Wednesday-Friday Schedule, 12:30-5:30 PM in a long-term nanny position caring for a four-month-old baby girl. Her parents are seeking an outgoing and supportive caregiver for their baby. They prefer a nanny with infant experience and an educational focus. Parents work in and out of the home. Pay range: \$14-15 per hour starting pay. Start date: ASAP.

Filled: Live-out Nanny Position in SE Boise: Providing attentive care for a one-year-old girl in a calm, interactive, and flexible style. The work schedule would be Tuesday to Friday, 7:30 to 4:00. The ideal candidate would be mature and have proven experience working with young toddlers in a home setting. A six-month commitment is requested.

Filled: Live-in Nanny position in Champaign, Illinois: A bi-lingual (preferably Spanish) nanny is needed to care for two young children (ages one and four) in a lake home near Champaign, Illinois. Nanny candidate must have experience working in a private home and excellent references from that employment. Nanny occasionally may be asked to travel with family and assist with household needs, and keep the home tidy on a day-to-day basis. Nanny must be able to cook healthy meals for children and may assist with family meals on occasion. General work hours: 7 AM to 5 PM. Pay range: \$500-

700 per week depending on experience and qualifications. Twelve-month commitment requested with long-term potential.

Filled: Live-out Part-time Nanny Position in Meridian: Two to three days per week caring for five-year-old twins. Specific days may vary according to a schedule that is set six weeks in advance. Eighty hours per month can be guaranteed. Duties include taking initiative in planning activities such as outings, sports, games, swimming, etc. and transporting children to/from kindergarten. Preparing nutritious meals and snacks and keeping things tidy are also important. Errands or light household tasks or dinner prep may be requested during the hours children are in half-day kindergarten. Pay range: \$13-14 per hour.

Filled: Live-out Nanny Position in Boise Foothills: Full-time Monday through Friday providing attentive care for one-year-old twins. This family is seeking an outgoing and engaging nanny that has an awareness of developmental milestones and can incorporate learning activities (language building, arts and crafts, etc.) into the children's regular routine. Planning outings to the park, zoo, etc. is important, as well as taking initiative on children's and (light) household needs that may arise. Pay range: \$14-16 per hour based on experience.

Filled: Live-out Nanny-Family Assistant Position In Star: Thirty to thirty-eight hours per week, four days --and occasionally five days-- per week, providing nurture and guidance to a brother and sister, ages six and four years old. (Also, there are two to four business trips per year when parents will ask their nanny to provide overnight care for the children.)

Parents prefer a nanny that will help foster a love of learning and exploring their world through activities, games, music, art, and outings. The family has a pool, so a swimmer is required. Other duties: Preparing healthy meals for the children and kitchen clean-up, assisting with basic dinner prep, keeping the home and children's things tidy, and other household errands/light duties as needed. Pay range: \$13-15 per hour plus paid vacation, sick days, and possible contribution to health insurance.

Filled: Live-out Part-time Nanny-Family Assistant Position in Meridian: Interacting with two young boys, ages one and four, and assisting with light household tasks. The boys enjoy the outdoors, active and imaginative play (pirates and adventure!) This family is seeking a nanny that will focus on the children, read lots of books to them, and model respect and kindness. The schedule will likely be Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, 10 AM to 5 PM plus two or three evenings per month and occasional weekend hours by prearrangement. Pay range: \$14-17 per hour based on experience.

Filled: Live-out Nanny Position in Eagle: Thirty to thirty-five hours per week, Monday through Thursday caring for a one-year-old boy and his new sibling arriving in October. Occasional or regular Friday hours are possible. Walks and outdoor time, reading, interaction and learning activities are important events in his daily routine. Other duties include helping with light household tasks and assisting with family dinner

preparation. Infant experience required. Pay range: \$13-15 per hour plus paid vacation. This family is seeking a long-term nanny (at least two years or more, if possible).

Filled: Live-out Nanny-Family Assistant Position in Eagle: Thirty to forty hours per week, Monday through Friday, with two boys (pre-school and a school-aged). Other duties: Light housekeeping, light cooking, regular grocery shopping, errands and transportation for children to activities and from school. This family is seeking a light-hearted nanny with a genuine love for children and that enjoys helping their household run smoothly. Pay range: \$13-16 per hour.

Filled: Live-out Nanny for Newborns in Mountain Home area: Mature grounded individual is needed to care for preemie multiples starting in April. Mon.-Fri. 7:30-5:30. To be considered, candidates must have solid infant care experience, and preemie or multiples experience would be a plus. Serious candidates must be willing to make an 18-month commitment, have reliable transportation and be a confident all-season driver. The focus for this position will be on infant needs, nurturing and helping the babies stay on their daily schedule, and supporting and working together with parents but also able to work independently. Communication skills, flexibility, and sound judgment are essential. Pay range: \$600-700 per week with possible gas stipend if driving from the Boise area or other distance.

Filled: Live-out Part-time Nanny Position in East Boise: A family expecting twins (possibly preemies) are seeking a nanny to assist with their two-year-old daughter and newborn twins on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8 AM to 4 or 5 PM. They are seeking a nanny that can be flexible with family needs as they are adjusting to the arrival of their infants. A nanny that is patient, calm, and can interact well with babies, toddlers, and parents is preferred. Preschool-age, infant and preemie experience is desired. Pay range: \$15-18 per hour.

Filled: Live-out Full-time Nanny Position in East Boise: This family is seeking a consistent and enthusiastic nanny that will give genuine care and guidance to their two preschool-aged girls. Their ideal nanny will help their children learn self-confidence and problem solving through their daily activities together. The schedule will generally be day hours Monday through Friday. Thirty-four hours per week can be guaranteed with some weeks up to 40 or more hours, so a nanny with a flexible attitude is needed for this position. Other skills needed for this position are healthy cooking, a sense of tidiness and organization, and the ability to plan creative activities –indoor and outdoor – for their girls. Pay range: \$14-16 per hour plus paid vacation.
