**Open: Live-out Nanny-Family Assistant Position in Boise:** This Monday through Friday position is a morning 7-11 AM schedule and involves assisting a five-year old with his morning routine and transporting him to school. The morning routine would include preparing and overseeing his breakfast, bath, and homework time. A nanny would use her vehicle to transport him to school (with gas reimbursement) and then return to the home to complete some household and dinner prep tasks. Because of the child's allergies, the car would need to be clean and free of pet dander. This is a three-month temporary position. Pay rate: \$14-17 per hour based on experience.

**Open: Live-out Nanny-Family Assistant Position in North Boise:** A newborn and his parents would love the assistance of an experienced nanny who has worked with newborns and young infants and is also proficient in helping with light household tasks and cooking for a family with "slightly picky" eaters. Thirty hours per week could be guaranteed and these would generally be daytime weekday hours with approximately two evenings per month and occasional weekend hours and short trips (Seattle) with advance notice. A calm positive style would be appreciated and schedule flexibility because the needs could vary from month to month. Start date: mid-February. Pay range: \$16-18 per hour --depending on experience-- and paid vacation. **Filled: Live-out Nanny-Family Assistant Position in North Boise:** A family with three pre-schoolers is seeking an energetic and super reliable nanny that can skillfully flow between childcare and assisting with household needs such as laundry, household organization, kitchen and other clean-up needs. An excellent candidate for this position would naturally set a great example for children with healthy eating and have cooking skills to match. She would enjoy reading to children, plan arts and crafts and learning activities for the children and have good ideas and suggestions, too. Highly valued is the ability to take common sense initiative with household and the children's needs and follow through without prompting. Other requirements: Ability to transport children to and from preschool and activities in family's vehicle, ability and willingness to swim with children, ability to travel with family occasionally, and willingness to work some evenings and occasional weekend hours on a monthly basis. Desirable: A mature nanny that has raised her own children and has life experience managing a household. Schedule: Two to three days per week with a 6:00 or 6:30 AM start time and availability for monthly evening and weekend hours, generally a total of twenty or more hours per

week. Starting pay range is \$13-15 per hour with a raise after ninety days for excellent performance and the opportunity to earn other incentives in the future.

**Filled:** Live-out Nanny-Family Assistant Position in Eagle: The focus of this position is a family with three school-aged children, ages five to thirteen. On school days, the typical schedule would be 2:30 to 8:00 PM and include picking up children from school and providing transportation to their activities, preparing healthy snacks and dinner for the children and homework supervision. Other duties would be maintaining tidiness in the home, and helping with dishes and laundry, shopping and errands. On school vacation days –including summer and Christmas break--, the schedule would typically be 7 AM to 6 PM (weekdays). Occasionally, but not typically, some weekend hours may be requested in advance along with the opportunity to travel out-of-state or out-of-country with the family. Desirable start date would be end of November or first part of December, when the best candidate is located. Pay range depends on the candidate's experience or qualifications in the general range of \$13-17 per hour. This is a long-term position.

**Filled:** Full-time Family Assistant Position in Boise Northend: A family with two school-aged children is seeking an experienced nanny and household manager that can help their weekly routine and household run smoothly. Important qualities would be flexibility, a natural sense of organization and ability to take common sense initiative on any needs in the household. Schedule flexibility is important in this position as the parents travel frequently and sometimes evening and or weekend hours are requested. A nanny with experience cooking well-balanced organic family meals would be a plus. Pay range: \$15-16 per hour plus PTO. Start date: As soon as the best candidate is located.

**Filled:** Full-time Nanny-Family Assistant Position in Eagle: This family includes two school-aged boys and four friendly dogs. This is an outdoorsy and athletic family that places a high priority on academics. They are seeking an upbeat and positive family assistant that can be a good role model to their boys and also independently take responsibility for household needs, cooking and errands while the boys are in school, providing transportation from school, to activities as well as driving to complete frequent household errands. Monitoring homework and afterschool routine is an important part of this position. Generally the schedule is Monday through Thursday day hours, but Fridays do occur, particularly in the summer. 30-35 hours per week during school year and approximately 40 hours per week in summer. Starting pay is \$14-15 per hour with two weeks of paid vacation.

**Filled:** Part-time Nanny-Family Assistant Position in Star: Assist this family with their two older school-age children, activities, outings, meals/light household tasks/organization on a work schedule that will change predictably every four months. The schedule will be a minimum of *thirty-two hours per month* (not weekly but monthly) and at times more will be offered. It will at times include evenings and overnights and rotate to afternoon hours based on the parents' travel and work schedules. Some months will be busier than others but a minimum monthly salary will be guaranteed with additional pay for additional hours. A nanny can expect the range of six to nine work days *per month*. The nanny work days will fall on Wednesday through Friday and occasional Saturdays. Sunday through Tuesday will consistently be days "off" for the nanny. Starting pay: \$14 per hour with stipend for overnight sleep time. Bonus: Free gym membership provided to nanny that she can use during work hours with the children or during her off hours.

**Filled:** Live-out Full-time Nanny Position in East Boise: Weekday schedule with occasional evening or weekend flexibility for an active family with a school-aged boy and twin preschoolers. Duties include childcare and activities/outings and assisting with preparing healthy meals (recipes provided) and household tasks. Energy and schedule flexibility are important qualities for this position. Start date: August 15. Pay range: \$14-15 per hour, generally 40 hours per week, but overtime pay for extra hours.

**Filled:** Live-out Full-time Family Assistant-Nanny Position in East Boise: Caring for two children (pre-school and kindergarten age) and household needs including cooking, laundry, tidying up, shopping, and

driving children to school and activities, and homework assistance. This family prefers a nanny that understands and can support their family's LDS faith. Also preferred is a creative nanny that would plan fun activities and outings with the children, particularly for the summer vacation. Work schedule is generally Mon/Tues/Thurs/Fri, 7 AM to 5 PM with occasional Wednesdays possible. Pay range: \$13-15 per hour based on experience. Ideal start date: Early June. One year commitment required.

**Filled:** Live-out Afternoon Nanny Position in East Boise: Child-focused care for a three-year-old girl from noon to five o'clock, Tuesday through Friday. Duties include transporting the child home from school, preparing the child's meals/snacks, planning activities and supporting her routine. There are occasions when full days may be needed (when the child is sick and can't attend her morning school program). An ideal candidate for this position would have experience with three-year-olds and/or a mature person that has raised children. Experience with asthma would be helpful. An eight-month commitment is requested. Pay: \$13-14 per hour range.

**Filled:** Live-out Summer Nanny Position in Star: A family with two young school-aged children would like a nanny Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursdays 8 AM to 5 PM to help facilitate a fun, active, and creative summer and encourage the children to try new experiences (sports/food/art, etc.) in a safe loving environment. Nanny candidates applying for this position must be physically active and willing and able to swim with children on a daily basis. Pay range: \$13-16 per hour depending on experience.

**Filled:** Live-out Position for Cook / Family Assistant in Boise: An experienced cook and caregiver is needed to assist an elderly couple in their home. The position includes preparing a homemade lunch and dinner and helping with shopping and laundry four to five hours per day, Monday through Friday. \$14-16 per hour.

**Filled:** Live-out Part-time Elder Companion Position in Boise: This senior couple is seeking an experienced and light-hearted caregiver to assist them. They wish to continue their independence, but would appreciate assistance with cooking, shopping, laundry, fall prevention, and transportation to outings in the community. They enjoy their home and beautiful garden, and especially visits from their large family. This position starts as soon as the right Companion is located. Schedule: 20-25 hours per week, Monday through Friday day hours. Pay range: \$13-17 per hour, depending on experience. This is a long-term position.

**Filled:** Live-out Full-time Family Assistant Position in SE Boise: This position is 50% household support and 50% childcare (two school-aged children). This family is seeking a FA that enjoys domestic tasks and child interaction and will support the family's values such as healthy organic lifestyle/cooking, outdoor activities (swimming, tennis, hiking, biking, gardening, nature) and creative learning activities (games, arts, building, science projects). Important qualities and abilities needed for this position: Open friendly communication skills and ability to interact well with parents and children, creativity, strong sense of cleanliness and organization, sincere love of home duties and children, dependability, and a strong interest in healthy/organic/gluten free cooking and/or desire to learn. Specific household duties include laundry, cooking (recipes and direction provided), pet bunny care, tidying (weekly cleaning service does deep cleaning), and transporting children from school and to some activities. Required: Ability and willingness to swim and play tennis **with** children and engage in other active outdoor / indoor activities (No TV, etc.) Schedule: 10 AM – 6 PM, Monday through Friday plus an occasional evening to be arranged in advance. Pay Range: \$13-16 per hour depending on candidate's experience/qualifications, plus paid time off.

**Filled:** Live-out Part-time Nanny Position in Boise North End: *Fifty to sixty hours* per month caring for a bright and energetic three-year-old girl. Hours are: Tuesdays (evenings 6-10 PM) and alternating Fridays (evening 6-10 PM) and alternating Saturdays (10 AM-9 PM). Also, there is one on-call week every five weeks that include only evening, night and weekend hours. Nanny just needs to be within fifteen or twenty minutes' drive of the family's home during on-call period. Reliability is very important. This family is seeking an upbeat and engaging nanny that will enjoy planning activities and outings for their child and support her evening and bedtime routine (bath, stories, etc). Other duties include light cooking and clean-

up, and helping to keep child's clothes, toys, etc. in order. Pay range possible: \$14-16 per hour. Start date: As soon as the ideal candidate is located.

**Filled: Live-out Family Assistant Position in East Boise:** Part-time (25-35 hours per week) caring for a young infant and assisting the family with light household tasks and cooking. The schedule is typically weekday hours and additionally one evening per week, possibly on the weekend. An excellent candidate for this position would have verifiable infant care experience caring for young babies, knowledge of infant growth and development, some schedule flexibility (a minimum of 25 hours per week can be guaranteed though schedule may vary on a monthly basis), and ability to assist with household tasks. Enjoyment of cooking and good recipe ideas is a plus! Pay range: \$15-16 per hour for qualified individual.

**Filled: Live-in Nanny Position in Boise:** Full-time, Monday through Friday day hours with occasional evening and weekend hours as pre-arranged. Nanny must be able to travel with family on short trips approximately four times per year. This family is seeking a friendly, dependable, flexible nanny that will provide engaging and learning-oriented care for their two young children. The ideal nanny would be a safe driver, clean and organized and be a good role model for the children with the ability to follow the parents' discipline model. Some cooking for children and family is required (healthy and basic) as well as assistance with laundry and grocery shopping and light tidying. Private furnished nanny suite and vehicle (for work and personal use) is provided. Salary is \$600 per week with paid vacation and holidays. A two-year commitment is requested. Pre-employment drug screening required.

**Filled: Live-out Family Assistant Position in Eagle:** Fifteen hours per week, generally an afternoon schedule assisting a family with three school-aged children. Duties include transporting children from school and to activities, overseeing children's homework, and helping with household tasks such as shopping, laundry, meal prep, errands, dog care, and tidying in the home. Also, FA must have the flexibility to stay overnights with the children when parents travel out-of-state, typically five days per month and may be asked to travel with the family from time to time. They would like to hire an assistant with an active lifestyle that will participate in activities with their children such as tennis, golf, horses, outdoors, and riding bikes, etc. Starting pay: \$15 per hour plus paid time off.

**Filled: Live-out Nanny-Family Assistant Position in Eagle:** Twenty to twenty-five hours per week Monday through Thursday from 11 / 12:00 noon to 5:00 PM. Friday hours are also possible some of the time. This position is assisting a family with three pre-schoolers and one school-age child. Duties will be engaging with children in activities indoors and outdoors (bikes, parks, golf, baseball, etc), monitoring homework, and transporting children from school and to activities, and assisting with household needs such as light cooking, laundry and helping to keep the home tidy and organized. These needs are shared with the stay-at-home mom. A nanny that is able to jump into the daily routine and be flexible with each day's needs would be a great fit for this family. Pay range based on experience: \$15-16 per hour or \$17 for exceptional experience, paid vacation. This is a long-term position.
